This programme aims to promote access to high-level engineering studies in one of the 7 INSA by supporting exceptional talent from diverse backgrounds.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- + Being a foreign student applying for a course offered by one of the 7 INSA
- + Have an excellent academic record
- + Be from one of the following countries: Brazil, Colombia, Vietnam, Romania and Côte d'Ivoire
- + Scholarships may also be awarded to students of other nationalities, depending on the quality of their application

HOW DO I APPLY?

Applications must be submitted on the recommendation of the INSA to which you are applying, using an application file available upon request from your INSA contact, including the following information in particular:

- + A summary of your academic background and your most recent transcripts
- + Your reasons for applying to the institute
- + Your career plans

+ A letter of recommendation from the INSA you are applying to

Selected students will be notified by the INSA Foundation within a maximum of one month after their application has been sent to their contact person. Scholarships will be paid to the students on their arrival in France in two instalments.
